5 Easy Steps for Using Parade Pomps

Need to create a float for a community or special cause parade? Not sure where to start? **We've got you covered!**

Start with a design (school name, year, mascot, etc). We can help you create it using parade pomps.



- **1** Gather the following supplies:
 - Pomps paste
 - □ Brush
 - □ Paste container
 - ☐ Tissue pomps
 - ☐ Chicken wire covered parade structure
- Apply pomp paste to a small area of the chicken wire.
- Place index finger in center of pomp and push tissue square 1/4 way through one chicken wire opening.
- Repeat step 3 to fill in the remaining openings. Spread more paste on an adjacent area and repeat the process.
 - **5.** Place the completely decorated structure on your parade float.

QUICK TIPS:

- Attach chicken wire to a flat frame (like photo at left) for the back end of your parade float.
- Bend the chicken wire to create large 3-D structures for the top of your float like mascots, footballs, etc.
- For large areas, place a pomp in every other wire hole. For denseness, use every hole.
- One package of tissue pomps, used in every other wire hole can cover 4 sq. ft.
